



## Approved Human Trafficking Prevention Courses for Health Care Practitioners

Please check with your licensing or certifying authority to determine which of the Health and Human Services Commission-approved courses are required for your profession, as well as for requirements regarding continuing education credits.

NOTE: The 89<sup>th</sup> Texas Legislature passed the following bills requiring additional professions to take human trafficking prevention training:

- [House Bill 742](#): First responders, including fire protection and emergency medical services personnel
- [House Bill 754](#): Medical assistants
- [House Bill 1778](#): Employees of tattoo and body piercing studios
